## SPEAKING YOUR FAITH

TEXT:	Matthew 9:27-31
KEY VERSE:	Matthew 9:27-29

God brought the animals to Adam to see what he would name them. God said, "What would you call this majestic creature, Adam?" And he said, "I believe that should be called a Lion, Sir." And God said, "I like the sound of that. One day my Son will be called 'the Lion of the Tribe of Judah.'" Then He said, "What do you call this humble creature?" And Adam said, "Oh! That must be called a Lamb." And God said, "I like that too. One day my Son will be called 'The Lamb of God.'" God breathed into man's nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul [lit. "Speaking Spirit"]. Just like God, what Adam spoke became1. AFTER Adam spoke his faith in the authority that The Father had given him, naming the animals, THEN God looked at His creation with Adam's names and said, "That is verifiably, certifiably good!" The only time God said that His creation was "very" good, was when His creation, man, joined with his Creator, God, in faith to finish His creation!

Man gave away that authority to Satan when he took the fruit...

...but then The Lion of the Tribe of Judah came, and restored man's place of rule.

...but then The Lamb of God came as the sacrifice, once for all, for sin, and restored man's place of righteousness.

So, Jesus said, "Have the faith of God, and don't doubt, and be a "Speaking Spirit" again, and move anything! And ask for whatever you want and believe that it is yours<sup>2</sup>."

But He gave them an authority that even the first Adam did not have:

And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

You have authority over the devil that stole Adam's authority, and he can never again take it away! So, speak to your mountain! Now, look what Jesus said to the two blind men:

And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou Son of David, have mercy on us. And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord. Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.

Two words of faith is enough to open blind eyes! Glory to God! They as much as said, "Sight be!" Sight was!
